Presentation Title: Provide a session title as it should appear in the program.

Lead Presenter: List name, title, institution, mailing address, home and office phone number, fax number, and e-mail.

Co-Presenters: List name, title, institution, mailing address, home and office phone number, fax number, and e-mail.

Proposal Format: (Please select one)

Thematic Paper/Research Sessions:

Submissions will be peer reviewed. Once accepted, individual sessions will be organized across the conference by thematic strand in 50-minute sessions.

Roundtable:

Submissions will be peer reviewed. Sessions provide opportunities for participants to share methods, strategies, or programs of interest to teacher educators through posters, technology assisted presentations, pictures, brochures, or other artifacts that promote discussion and interactions among conference participants.

Subject descriptors: Identify the conference thematic strand this presentation most closely relates to and include three one- or two-word descriptors for the subject index.

Goals and objectives: List the specific goals and objectives for the proposed session.

Abstract of Presentation: 200 words or fewer. Be clear, concise and thorough.

Conference Strand(s) Connection: Describe how the proposed presentation relates to the conference theme "A Vision for Teacher Education: Charting a Course toward Excellence, Innovation, and Impact" and appropriate strand(s)?

Summary for Conference Program: 50 words or less that would appear in the conference program: Be precise in describing the content of the session to aid attendees in selecting topics relevant to their interests. Proposals which do not include this summary or go beyond the fifty word limit may not be considered. Summary may be edited by the Program Committee prior to the conference.

Audience Participation: Briefly explain how you will involve the audience.

Technology needs: All technology needs should be furnished by the presenters or arranged with the hotel directly.

Deadline for Submission: May 31, 2009
